



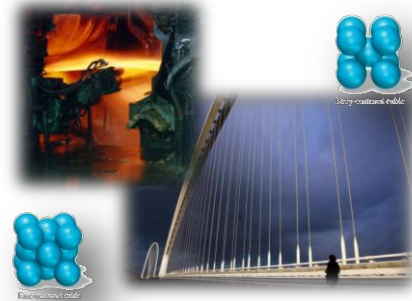

## ***VeMet-Luiten Grant***

Materials are all around us, and form the basis for our technological society. Materials partly determine the progress that can be made in realising a sustainable balance between technology and environment. The Dutch Metals Association, *VeMet*, focusses on the important materials class METALS and offers a €5000 grant in 2014 for a foreign secondment of a student or employee working on metals. The main criteria for obtaining the grant are:

- Metallurgical contents
- Quality of the receiving institution (foreign university or company)
- Purpose of the secondment within the education or career of the grantee
- Contribution to the reinforcement of metallurgical knowledge and sustainable usage of metals



Candidates must submit their application before June 1, 2014 (in Dutch or English), containing:

1. Curriculum Vitae and contact data
2. Motivation Letter
3. Description of the contents and aim of the secondment
4. Motivation of the choice of receiving institution and supervisor from the home institution
5. Contribution to the reinforcement of metallurgical knowledge and sustainable usage of metals
6. Concise financial planning

The Board of VeMet will announce their decision on the Luiten Grant award at the yearly VeMet Day, on Thursday June 26.
